CONVENIENT ACCESSIBILITY

Temuco is easily accessible from Santiago, Punta Arenas in southern Patagonia and Bariloche in Argentina. A scenic 1hr 30min drive will take you into Pućon, and just 20min beyond that, to the luxurious &Beyond Vira Vira. HISTORY OF THE MAPUCHE This area, stretching over 99km²

(38m²), was once a war ground where the Mapuche people battled the Inca and Spanish invaders. Now, these thriving farmlands form a colourful tapestry of quaint Mapuche communities that are benefitting from tourism.

SANTIAGO TO TEMUCO

1hr 20min flight (5 to 6 flights daily), followed by a 77km / 1hr 40mins road transfer to the lodge*

PUNTA ARENAS TO TEMUCO

2hr 30min flight for guests coming from Torres del Paine National Park in Patagonia, Antarctica or Australis cruises from Argentina, followed by a 77km / 1hr 40mins road transfer to the lodge*

PUCON AIRPORT

Private charter flights only. Fly from Santiago, Puerto Montt, Bariloche, Punta Arenas or others (Customs and immigrations can be organised in advance), followed by a 11km / 15mins road transfer to the lodge* PUNTA ARENAS TO PUERTO MONTT 2hr 10min flight, followed by a scenic 352km / 4hr 30mins road transfer through the Lake District to the lodge*

BUENOS AIRES TO BARILOCHE 2hr 20min flight, followed by a

ASCENSION OF VILLARRICA VOLCANO

Measuring an impressive 2847 m (9341 ft), the Villarrica Volcano features the perfect cone shape with an open lava pool crater at the top. From the summit, view a textured landscape of mountains, volcanoes and countless lakes. Mountain boots, walking poles, ice axe, crampons, helmet and trekking backpack will be provided.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Explore the rugged landscapes of Villarrica National Park, cycle around the tranquil Villarrica Lake, and climb craggy craters at the foot of the Villarrica Volcano on your bike. Choose between easy going, non-technical off-road biking and smooth flowing single track or, for technically skilled riders, extreme downhill adventures.

BIRDWATCHING

Exciting excursions allow birders to visit different habitats, such as mountains, lakes, rivers and forests to search high and low for iconic species in the area. At times, bird calls might lead you to sightings of the giant magellanic woodpecker, ringed kingfisher, chucao tapaculo, snowy egret, black-crowned night heron, plumbeous rail and Andean condor, to name a few. A walk around the lodge estate is also a must for keen birders.

HORSEBACK RIDING After a short, scenic 4x4 drive

After a short, scenic 4x4 drive from the lodge, arrive at Huepil Malal, a horse-riding centre bordering the Cañi Natural Reserve. Here, you will meet an authentic Chilean huaso (cowboy). His horses are typical Chilean breeds with names like Merken, Calafate or Canela. You will be guided on a scenic tour through open prairies and forests. This excursion is for all abilities, from those who just wish to meander to advanced riders.

WHITE-WATER RAFTING

Hang on tight as you race over rapids on a thrilling white-water rafting adventure. Before setting off, there will be a safety briefing and testing of the equipment. Ideal for beginners and experienced paddlers, the Trancura River features Class 3 and 4 rapids. Zigzagging through valleys and gullies, there are numerous runs and rapids including the Junction, the Lioness, the Wall and the Footbridge.

CATCH-AND-RELEASE FISHING

Spend a day immersed in the spectacular surrounds of &Beyond Vira Vira, with just the sounds of a streaming river or lapping lake as your companion, and enjoy either fly-fishing or spinner fishing where all equipment is provided. Cast your line in front of your villa for rainbow trout, brown trout, or chinook salmon or choose to go out in a boat to explore a wider expanse. Our guide will show vou the best spots for both river and lake fishing, providing you with some expert tips.



Enjoy a fun day out splashing in the pristine waters around &Beyond Vira Vira. Starting at the lodge, paddle down the Liucura River, and take in the spectacular natural surrounds of volcanoes, kaleidoscopic birds swooping through the air, and lush forests. Additionally, we can arrange stand-up paddle boarding on Lake Tinquilco for a change of scenery.

KAYAKING Situated at Lake Tinguilco,

in the Huerquehue National Park, embark on an hour-long adventure around the lake. Surrounded by mountains and beautiful forest, reach the opposite shore and walk along a trail to cascading waterfalls. For the more adventurous and advanced paddlers, there are plenty of options in the Pucón and Villarrica area to test their skill.

MAPUCHE RUKA & WEAVING TOUR

Step into another culture with a fascinating visit to doña Rosario's ruka (house) in the local Mapuche community. Embracing traditional ways, watch her roasting organic wheat the way it has been prepared for centuries, and enjoy her delicious home cooked fare. Get active and enjoy a game of Palin - a traditional Mapuche stick and ball game, that originated in southern Chile. From here, guests meet Sandra Rojos and have the opportunity to visit her factory and watch her working the loom.



CHEESE FACTORY TOUR

Located on the &Beyond Vira Vira property is a cheese factory (quesería). Local cheese maker, Marisol Martinez, is renowned for her wholesome, authentic and flavourful cheeses for the exclusive delight of our guests. The ultimate foodie delight, enjoy a tour of this delicious quesería and gain insight into the specific ways different cheese, including Parmesan, Gruyère, Blue cheese and Camembert are produced. These can all be sampled during mealtimes.

COMMUNITY VISIT

Explore the charming town of Curarrehue and visit a Mapuche weaver to view her traditional skills and techniques as she works with the loom. Afterwards, continue up into the Andes to the Quillelhue Lagoon, located at the foot of Lanin Volcano. Here you will have the opportunity to see the majestic araucaría trees (known as monkey puzzle trees), followed by a lunch at a traditional Mapuche ruka (house). During your visit, learn about their unique ways of life first hand.

Winter activities

For snow enthusiasts, this pristine snow-filled playground promises an adventure unlike any other.







Exciting adventures await with our snowboarding and skiing activities down the active Villarrica Volcano. A variety of slopes are on offer from beginner to more advanced ski runs. A spectacular environment of volcanic peaks and shimmering lakes, the flowing lava has created an incredible terrain of natural half pipes, cornices and wind lips.

SNOWSHOEING

Embark on a snowshoe trekking expedition through puffy snow as you carve trails around Villarrica National Park. This is an excellent way to explore untouched landscapes, with absolute silence dominating the vast expanse surrounding you. The Andes is a magical winter space between June and September, and snowshoeing is an exceptional experience created for all levels of fitness. This exciting adventure begins and ends with steaming mugs of hot chocolate.

SNOWMOBILING

Skiing on the active Villarrica Volcano is spectacular, but racing on a snowmobile becomes a once in a lifetime experience. Together with your driver/guide, circle the volcano finding a virgin track on every run. This activity is designed for adventure lovers, and as the snowmobiles function similar to a motorbike, you will have to hang on and lean in according to your driver's instructions.

DOG SLEDDING

Be captivated by this experience as you crisscross the snowfall on a husky sledding adventure. Head to Villarrica, and hop aboard a special snow vehicle that will take you to to a team of experienced sled dogs, eager to propel you through the snow. Enjoy a gentle walk at the foot of the volcano through a lava slag covered in snow and surrounded by araucaría (monkey puzzle) trees.

ORGANIC PRODUCE Bountiful vegetable garden provides fresh, organic produce for the lodge kitchen WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT 100% of the lodge's grey wastewater is recycled for irrigation purposes WASTE RECYCLING An active programme on the farm supports the reuse and recycling of organic waste

WATER BOTTLING PLANT Approximately 10 000 plastic water bottles are eliminated each year through our on-site water bottling plant

REFORESTATION PROJECT Over 150 indigenous saplings, sourced from the local Quelhue community nursery, have been planted since September 2018

SUSTAINABILITY AUDIT An internal system of monthly reports against Group impact goals is supported by an annual sustainability audit

ENERGY SAVINGS 100% of the lodge's central heating is generated by certified wood pellets; LED bulbs are fitted throughout the lodge, both indoor and outdoor

CARE OF The Wildlife

CONSERVATION LESSONS

A conservation-lessons collaboration with the Quelhue Elementary School is planned later in 2021. Environmental education is one of the main pillars of the school's values. These include practical curricular content, such as greenhouse cultivation in the school garden, educational outings, internet research and the creation of texts and mini-books that have been published and are now available at the nearby Pucón town library.

LOCAL PROCUREMENT 100% of our produce is sourced locally - most of it within 15 - 30 km (9 - 18 mi.) actively reducing our carbon footprint

LOCAL EMPLOYMENT 97% of staff are Chilean nationals; 70% from Pucón and surrounds

LODGE TRAINING INTERNSHIPS Nine students have completed three-month internships at the lodge since September 2018

COVID-19 IMPACT AND RESPONSE A total of CLP 6 000 000 raised for food relief assistance to support 37 families from a school in the local Quelhue community. Baskets of vegetables harvested from the organic garden by the lodge team, were delivered, together with food parcels, to 5 families in the town of Curarrehue.
