Choose to delve into the African Penguin & Seabird Sanctuary, and splurge on a whale watching trip (dependent on the season), where conservationists will have a chance to showcase their marine conservation initiatives along South Africa's magnificent coastline.



Day 1:

Upon arrival at OR Tambo International Airport, you will be met by a Menzies Aviation representative and assisted through customs and immigration. You will then be assisted with check in procedures for your onward flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport, followed by a Federal Airlines shuttle flight to Phinda Airfield.

Conservation fees apply to all ages

Rejuvenate during your 3 night stay at andBeyond Phinda Mountain Lodge in a family cottage with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, refreshments on game drives, laundry, safari activities, 1-hour nature walks accompanied by experienced armed trackers (subject to availability), emergency medical evacuation insurance, VAT, transfers to and from the lodge airstrip, Guides' Journal with illustrated wildlife and vegetation checklist and an area map with illustrated Star Birds checklist. SWAROVSKI OPTIK binoculars (one pair per room to use throughout stay).

Designed for families with children who are wanting to experience the wonders of the African bush together, each safari is planned with the guide taking into account the childrens ages, their interests, the familys preferences and fun seasonal activities available.

Day 2:

A visit to Wild Impact's* various projects situated in the communities adjacent to Phinda Private Game Reserve. Projects have three areas of focus, health, education and income generation. If the trip is prebooked, the Regional Coordinator responsible for the area will guide it (this activity is only available on weekdays). (*Formerly known as Africa Foundation)

Visit a Zulu community just outside &Beyond Phinda Private Game Reserve and interact with the friendly people of KwaZulu-Natal. A Bantu tribal group, the Zulu are the largest ethnic group in South Africa. A local &Beyond guide will escort you through the community and share interesting insights and narratives about Zulu culture and its fascinating customs, beliefs and traditions.









You will be invited into a traditional Zulu homestead and given the rare opportunity to witness the daily routines and lifestyle of an authentic, rural Zulu family where eons of tradition intersect with modern life. Learn about the family structures, patriarchal duties, and matriarchal responsibilities of the tribe, find out how local homes are constructed and why cattle are so valuable and highly revered.

Spend time with the respected local sangoma, a witch doctor and traditional healer, who will explain the significance of the ancestors in Zulu life, as well as the tribe's spiritual beliefs and the importance of their sacred lands.

The adventure ends with a quick stop at the Mbhedula Craft Market, where the beautiful handiwork and art of 43 Zulu crafters is showcased. It's a great place to find that perfect souvenir of your time with the Zulu people.

Day 3:

The vast sandy beaches of the Maputaland coastline provide a beautiful setting for this half-day beach outing to beautiful Sodwana Bay. There is ample time for you to soak up the warm African sun and splash in the clear, temperate waters of the Indian Ocean, bordered by miles and miles of sandy beaches. The diverse area is stippled with rugged foothills, flanked by dense dune vegetation and the azure hues of the tropical Indian Ocean. Marvel at the ever-changing forms of the golden sand dunes, constantly shifted by the winds and tides. Interspersed between the shimmering, gilded sands jut craggy mounds teeming with a dense accumulations of rich minerals and ruddy sediments. Relax with a good book, play fun filled beach games and take leisurely walks along the pristine shoreline, which blends effortlessly with the animated ocean, awash with the sound of the waves and the cries of various sea birds. At low tide you can snorkel alongside Jesser Point, a protected marine reserve, and marvel at an endless abundance of diverse and colourful marine life. Jesser Point features a rock-strewn point at the south corner of the bay, perfect for fishing off the rocks at low ride and from the safety of the bay at high tide.

Set within easy reach of the Indian Ocean coastline and the famous iSimangaliso / Greater St Lucia Wetland Park in northern KwaZulu-Natal, &Beyond Phinda Private Game Reserve is known for its abundant wildlife, diversity of habitats and wide range of safari activities. Thanks to its coastal rainfall pattern, the Reserve enjoys a lush green environment that contains seven distinct ecosystems. &Beyond Phinda is often referred to as 'Seven Worlds of Wonder.' This fascinating variety of landscape and vegetation shelters an abundance of wildlife, including not only the Big Five but many rarer and less easily spotted species, such as the elusive cheetah or the scarce black rhino. With only a handful of lodges sharing an area of 28 555 hectares, and expert rangers and trackers in search of prime wildlife sightings, guests are assured an exclusive game viewing experience. Adding to Phinda's wildlife charms, the marine diversity of nearby Sodwana Bay on the coast is easily accessible, with scuba diving, fishing and even turtle watching only some of the adventures available from Phinda.

Sink into one of the inviting sofas on the deck and indulge in a creamy cappuccino while you watch the sunrise.

Ask the chef for one of Phinda Mountain's famous chelsea buns - sticky, sweet and delicious. The chef might even share the recipe!

Track one of Africa's rarest large mammals, the highly endangered black rhino, on foot.

Day 4:

Your Federal Air flight from and Beyond Phinda Mountain Lodge to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport will be followed by an Airlink connection flight to Cape Town.

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport you will be met by a member from our andBeyond team who will drive you from Cape Town International Airport to Babylonstoren. You can look forward to exploring one of the most beautiful and famous wineland districts in the world. A discovery of top class wines, locally produced cheeses, olives and much more awaits you.

Indulge during your 4 nights stay at Babylonstoren in a Two Bedroom Fynbos Cottage with ensuite bathrooms. Your stay includes breakfast, still and sparkling water (replaced daily), a larder containing a bottle of red and white wine as well as fresh juice on arrival, water buffalo tour to Rietvlei, full access to the garden at all times, guided garden tours and farm walk, cycling and canoeing or rowing on the farm dam, fishing and fly-fishing, mountain drive (for a 2-night stay and longer), daily stretch and breathing sessions at Babylonstoren Balance, bread baking with bakers, cellar tour and wine tasting, olive oil and balsamic vinegar tour, a special treasure hunt for young guests and essential oil tour.

Day 5:

Combine wine tasting for the adults with a range of activities designed to keep the children happy on this family tour of the picturesque Cape Winelands. Kick off the day at the Spice Route Winery, where you can indulge your taste buds with wine and beer tasting while younger guests sample the local chocolate and biltong. Wide lawns on offer, the ideal place for children to play. The next stop is Le Bonheur Crocodile Farm, where you will be taken on a tour of the crocodile ponds, which houses more than a thousand of the reptiles. Young guests will be delighted with the opportunity to touch a baby crocodile and, in summer months, will also be able to witness the daily feeding. The day ends at Pigcasso, expect to be overwhelmed with solitude - this is a sanctuary, after all. Meet everyone's 'second favourite', resident cow 'Balloo' - and view the available artworks at the onsite OINK Gallery. Please note that the wine estates visited on this tour may be amended according to guests' preferences.

Day 6:

The Uthando Tour (only possible on weekdays) covers an extensive discussion on South African history, the legacy of Apartheid, political, social, economic, cultural and local issues. As Uthando is a Non-Profit Company focused on community upliftment, the core of our trips is taking people to visit interesting community development projects. We work with, support and visit many different types of projects, for example: day care / early learning centres, urban agricultural and environmental programmes, youth development / after school programmes where children are taught dance, music, sports etc., an old age project, animal care projects and many more. Visits depend on what projects are available on the day and tours are normally arranged the day before depending on availability of the projects. On every half day tour we take guests to visit 3 different community projects. Guests have an opportunity to interact with the locals at these projects, find out about the inspiring work they are doing. The projects showcase their work and lives to the visitors.

Day 7:

Explore the scenic city of Cape Town on a family adventure that begins with a ride on the revolving cable car up to the top of iconic Table Mountain. Marvel at spectacular views over the city and the entire Cape Peninsula as you stroll along its flat top or, if the weather is not favourable, explore the smaller peak known as Signal Hill. From here, travel to Company Gardens, set up in the 17th century as a fresh produce garden used to supply ships stopping in the harbour and now home to the SA Museum, Cultural History Museum, Houses of Parliament, National Gallery and St George's Cathedral. Next, witness one of Cape Town's oldest traditions as you head up to Signal Hill for the firing of the noonday gun. Taking place every day except Sundays, this involves the firing of the world's oldest cannons charged by gunpowder that are still in daily use. Originally intended to provide a time signal for ships anchored in the bay, this maritime tradition continues to this day. From here, you will visit the traditional Malay Quarter, situated in the predominantly Muslim Bo-Kaap. Admire the area's brightly coloured houses, which date back as far as the 17th century and get a glimpse into one of the Cape's many vibrant cultures. The day's adventure ends at the V&A Waterfront, with an opportunity to explore the Two Oceans Aquarium, which houses one of the best marine collections in the world. The Aquarium showcases the variety of marine species that live in both the Indian and the Atlantic Oceans, with a number of exhibits designed especially to provide up-close, interactive experiences for children. Once you have explored to your



heart's content, enjoy lunch at one of the many popular restaurants at the Waterfront.

Enjoy a wonderful family holiday and stay at the Fynbos Family House, an exclusive-use home that sleeps 10 with five en-suite bedrooms, each with a cosy fireplace and glorious tubs for bubble baths. Leading off the spacious lounge is a fully equipped kitchen. A central courtyard is the ideal spot for family and friends to gather with a sparkling pool for refreshing swims.

A wonderful outdoor adventure awaits the children here, and they can enjoy the farm and feed the donkeys, collect eggs and pick delicious fresh fruit and vegetables from the garden. They can also bake scrumptious breads with the bakers and get messy with kneading the dough and run around in the sunny outdoors on a scavenger hunt.

Guests will be enticed to pick their own fresh produce from the gardens and whip up their own meals or savour the incredible culinary fare served at Babel, the hotel's five-star restaurant. At the heart of the farm is a fantastic vegetable and fruit garden, inspired by the famed company gardens of the Dutch East India Company. After a workout in the fully equipped gym overlooking the garden, guests can unwind with massages at the spa or take advantage of the sauna, steam baths or indoor plunge pool. Those who want to stretch their legs can enjoy birdwatching, take the kids to visit the nearby Le Bonheur Crocodile Farm, go golfing at the Boschenmeer and Pearl Valley courses or simply stroll around the farm.

Day 8:

After breakfast, a member from our andBeyond team will collect you from Babylonstoren and transfer you to Grootbos. Duration of the transfer is up to 3 hours.

Indulge during your 3 night stay at Grootbos Private Nature Reserve at Garden Lodge in a Two Bedroom Luxury Family Suite with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes welcome drink served upon arrival, water, soft drinks, tea and coffee, minibar, fresh fruit daily in suite, breakfast, light lunch, 5-course dinner, horse riding through the reserve, but not on the beach (weight limit 90kg/198lbs per person; children under the age of 12 only allowed on guided pony rides), Botanical Fynbos hike on the reserve, milkwood forest walk, 4x4 Flower Safari, coastal drives with seasonal land-based whale watching (whale watching especially during July - December), beach Picnics, ancient Klipgat Cave and Walker Bay Nature Reserve beach excursion, progressive Tourism Tour, bird-watching; experience a great variety of bird species on the reserve, various maps of the reserve and the area for self-guided walks and transfers to/from all activities, children activities, i.e., treasure hunts through the forest and fynbos, pony rides and arts & crafts in the dedicated children playroom and transfers to/from all activities for included activities.

Day 9:

Established in 2003, our Green Futures Horticulture and Life Skills College provides educational training to 8-12 unemployed young adults each year. We aim to give our student candidates the skills and confidence necessary to market themselves and become employable, while at the same time contributing to the conservation and promotion of our region's unique biodiversity. The fully accredited (AGRISeta) course combines essential life skills like personal finance, business skills, computers, driving and health education with knowledge of environmental and conservation issues, and skills of horticulture and landscaping. On completion of their course, the students are awarded a nationally (SETA) accredited certificate in horticulture and are assisted in work placement. Successful students can also apply for a second year of tuition in (FGASA) field guiding level 1. Since its inception, over 158 young people have graduated, and more than 90% of graduates have found employment on completion of the course.

Day 10:

You will be collected from Grootbos Private Nature Reserve and driven to Grootbos Private Nature Reserve.

Morning activity (January to May): Eco Marine Trip

Depart on an Eco Marine Trip. This 1 to 2 hour journey takes you to Dyer Island and the adjacent coast. We frequently see Dolphins along the beach. At Dyer Island we will look for interesting sea birds such as African Penguins, Terns, Cormorants, Petrels and Oystercatchers. A narrow channel known as Shark Alley separates Dyer Island and Geyser Rock, home to a colony of 60 000 Cape Fur Seals. This is a world-renowned location for viewing and cage diving with Great White Sharks. Please note that the duration of a transfer between Cape Town and Gansbaai (at an additional charge) would be approximately 2 hours in each direction.

Morning activity (June - December): Whale Watching Trip

You will depart on a Whale Watching Trip. Whales won't be the only things youll see on this unforgettable 2 hour adventure. Your boat will launch in the quaint harbour of Kleinbaai, in Gansbaai, and will make its way toward the Pearly Beach area which is home to the southern right whale. Afterwards, you will venture towards renowned Dyer Island for excellent penguin and seabird viewing, and then to Geyser Rock to view the curious antics of Cape fur seals. Between these two islands is the notorious shark alley where you may be fortunate enough to view the spectacular great white shark.

Afternoon activity: African Seabird and Penguin Sanctuary

The African Penguin & Seabird Sanctuary (APSS) is a Dyer Island Conservation Trust (DICT) project based in Gansbaai. A state of the art facility, designed and built by passionate experts, that strives to provide local marine avian species with a local rehabilitative centre where injured, diseased or distressed birds can be treated and rehabilitated. Although the facility was purpose built for rehabilitation of marine birds, it also caters for creating awareness around the perils marine birds face out in the wild. An Auditorium equipped with a big screen TV, which is linked up to the Rehabilitation area and the Bird Hospital, enables guests who visit the facility to see what is being done behind the scenes. This prevents added stress on the birds in rehabilitation by minimizing the amount of people allowed in the critical areas. The Auditorium has one way glass overlooking the Conditioning Pen - where visitors can watch birds in final preparation for release without any disturbance or interference. The greatest care is taken with cleanliness and special flooring Is used in the rehabilitation area to avoid a condition called bumblefoot that penguins are susceptible to. A curio shop selling penguin curios is on site. Coffee and cake is available. All purchases in this regard help support the sanctuary. Entrance is free. The sanctuary depends heavily on



donations and a sponsorship brick can be purchased to contribute to the centre with tiered levels of support.
