Journey overview

Combine exceptional game viewing in one of South Africa's best known game reserves with the majestic Victoria Falls and the scenic beauty of laid-back Cape Town on this 12 Day Itinerary.

Begin your safari at andBeyond Ngala Private Game Reserve. Meaning "lion" in Shangaan, Ngala lives up to its name, supporting several prides of these powerful cats. This is one of the richest wildlife regions on the continent, with a great diversity of large and spectacular wildlife. The next stop on your journey takes you to the renowned Sabi Sand Game Reserve, the most prestigious game reserve in South Africa. With one of the richest game populations in the country, the chances of seeing the Big Five (lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant and rhino) are excellent.

After your safari, you head to Zimbabwe and the Victoria Falls. A World Heritage Site, the Victoria Falls is one of the world's greatest natural spectacles and the stuff of legends, romance and myth. Revel in the sense of the history of this quaint little frontier town and marvel at the magnificent sight of the world's largest curtain of falling water.

Your journey ends in the city of Cape Town. Relax on the city's golden beaches, discover mementoes of its colourful past and immerse yourself in its vibrant culture. Vibrant, cosmopolitan and an eclectic mix of old and new, this laid-back city is as much at home with its 17th-century castle - whose cannons have never been fired in anger - as it is with its sleek skyscrapers and trendy malls.

andBeyond Kirkman's Kamp

Sabi Sand Nature Reserve, South Africa

andBeyond Kirkman's Kamp, with its spectacular views of the unspoiled wilderness, is regarded as one of the best loved lodges in the Sabi Sand Game Reserve. It is a well known historic camp, originally built in the early 1920's, and celebrates the atmosphere of an early South African lowveld homestead. The colonial atmosphere of gracious style and luxury has been retained, and guests step back in time upon entering the original homestead, which now houses the Lodge's sitting, dining and bar areas. Each of the 18 guest cottages has a private veranda and is furnished in the same charming style with ensuite bathrooms. The large sitting room, with a 1920's ambience, leads through double French doors onto rolling lawns that provide a velvety contrast to the wild and tumbling bush surrounding the Lodge. Breakfast and lunch are served on shady verandas, and dinners are shared in the dramatic boma or in romantic lanternlit bush settings.

WHAT WE LOVE ABOUT KIRKMAN'S KAMP

Take time-out after a successful day of game viewing and head to the pool area. It boasts breathtaking views and leopard are often seen here too.

Savour a classic cocktail in Paul's Pub and, whilst you're there, list the day's exciting sightings on the chalk board.

Toast the sun as it sets over another magical day in Africa with an artisanal gin, sipped under the shade of a 650 year old fig tree.

Enjoy an afternoon of tennis on a court that was originally opened by legendary player, Billie Jean King.

Find original antiques scattered around the lodge that have been handed down over the decades, and what give this 1920's homestead its authentic "Out of Africa" feel. Ask your hosts about the fascinating history of &Beyond Kirkman's Kamp.

You will be collected from andBeyond Kirkman's Kamp and driven by private vehicle to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. Approximately 2 hours.

Connect onto your scheduled regional flight from Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport to Victoria Falls International Airport, where you will be collected and driven, with fellow guests, to Old Drift Lodge.

Explore the sights of Victoria Falls during your 2 night stay at Old Drift Lodge in a Tented Suite with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes all meals, drinks, mini bars in the suites, return transfers ex Victoria falls or Livingston airport, shuttle transfers to Vitoria Falls town, emergency medical evacuation cover, activities(time & weather permitting): Morning or afternoon game drives in Zambezi National Park, morning or afternoon River Safaris, morning or afternoon guided Walking safaris, a breakfast, brunch or lunch at the Lookout Cage - per stay - including drinks, guided Tour of the falls - Zimbabwe(excluding entry fees).

Day 9:

You will be collected from Old Drift Lodge and driven with fellow guests to Victoria Falls International Airport.

Scheduled regional flight from Victoria Falls International Airport to Cape Town International Airport.

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, you will be met by a Menzies Aviation representative and assisted through customs and immigration. You will then be assisted into the arrivals hall where you will be met by a member from our andBeyond team who will drive you to Mount Nelson, A Belmond Hotel, Cape Town.

As you drive toward the city, your view from afar will be Table Mountain, one of the most spiritual places on earth, with its heart, two oceans and the beautiful city of Cape Town at its feet.

Delight in your 3 night stay at Mount Nelson, A Belmond Hotel in a Superior Room with ensuite bathroom. Your stay includes breakfast.

Day 10:

Begin this scenic tour of Cape Town at iconic Table Mountain or, if the weather is not favourable, at the flat-topped mound known as Signal Hill. Browse vibrant Greenmarket Square, one of the city's oldest markets, and take a walk through Company Gardens, established by Dutch settlers in 1652. Drive past the Houses of Parliament and the historical Castle of Good Hope, as well as the Slave Lodge, which used to house thousands of slaves belonging to the Dutch East India Company. Next you will visit the traditional Malay Quarter in the predominantly Muslim Bo-Kaap, with its brightly coloured houses dating back as far as the 17th century. Pause to listen to the firing of the noonday gun from Signal Hill. Table Mountain closed 15 July - 1 September annually (subject to change).

Day 11:

This full-day tour takes in the scenic highlights of the Cape Peninsula, beginning at the spectacular coastal suburb of Hout Bay, a former fishing village with a long, sandy beach facing a bay framed by the mountains. Explore the restaurants, shops and markets of Mariner's Wharf, a harbour-front emporium with a distinct maritime ambiance. Depending on whether the road is open, the tour will continue along the breath-taking Chapman's Peak Drive before heading to the Cape of Good Hope to explore the nature reserve, see the Diaz Cross and perhaps even indulge in lunch at a local restaurant. From here you will travel to Simon's Town, famous for its naval military base, and then visit the charming penguin colony at Boulders Beach. The tour ends at the beautiful Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens, set against the eastern slopes of spectacular Table Mountain.

- The Victoria Falls can be viewed from both Zimbabwe and Zambia. The Zimbabwean side offers a greater number of spectacular viewing points. During the dry season, between September and December, the eastern cataract on the Zambian side of the falls tends to dry up dramatically whilst the Zimbabwean side continues to provide amazing views
- A supplement might apply for Cape Town accommodation over certain event dates (e.g. Mining Indaba and Opening of Parliament in February, Easter in March/April as well as AfricaCom and Oil Week in October/November) - exact dates only available closer to the time
- The Table Mountain Cable Way will be closed for its annual maintenance from around 15 July to around 1 September (exact dates have not been finalised for 2025)
- Validity periods are as specified above, should a booking fall over two rate periods the rate will change and we reserve the right to re-quote
